The concept of the Garland Music Festival, when it was inaugurated in 1978, was to offer all boys the opportunity to perform. The Festival has since developed into a prestigious event in the annual music calendar, but the simple and brilliant rationale of opportunity for performance remains. We hope that as many boys as possible in all years will avail themselves of this marvellous opportunity.

The **Garland Music Prize** for 2019 is \$200 for the Senior School Winner, \$100 for the Middle School Winner and \$50 for the Junior School Winner. The Garland Music Trophies are presented to the most outstanding performances of the competition.

In addition to the Garland Music Prize, the following will also be awarded to Senior School students:

- The **Gladstones Piano Cup** will be awarded to the most outstanding pianist
- The **Clarke Choral Cup** will be awarded to the most outstanding singer
- The **Bernard Harvey Brass Award** will be awarded to the most outstanding brass player
- The **Hale String Shield** will be awarded to the most outstanding string player
- The **Hale Woodwind Cup** will be awarded to the most outstanding woodwind player
- The **Hale Guitar Cup** will be awarded to the most outstanding guitarist
- The **Hale Percussion Shield** will be awarded to the most outstanding percussionist
- The **Barlow Ensemble Shield** for Western Art Music, a **Jazz Ensemble Shield** and a **Contemporary Ensemble Shield**

The **Friends of Hale Music Encouragement Award** for outstanding musical potential (this year the FOHM Award will go to a Middle School or Junior School student)

RULES FOR ENTRY

1. All details must be accurately recorded on the entry form. Submit only one entry form for each item.
2. You may enter as many solo sections as you wish but you may only perform ONCE in each section. You may perform more than once in the Ensemble section.
3. Your piece/s must not run over eight (8) minutes in duration.
4. ACCOMPANISTS:
 - a. Where you are to provide your own accompanist, you must bear the cost of this yourself.
 - b. Junior School
 - i. Hale School will provide accompanists in all sections for Junior School students. A 'run through' with your accompanist will be scheduled prior to Sunday 19 May and will be communicated to you via email. Accompaniment is of no cost to you. If you do require piano accompaniment, please attach a copy of the piano part to your entry form.
 - c. Middle School
 - i. Hale School will provide accompanists in all sections for Middle School students. A 'run through' with your accompanist will be scheduled prior to Sunday 19 May and will be communicated to you via email. Accompaniment is of no cost to you. If you do require piano accompaniment, please attach a copy of the piano part to your entry form.
 - d. Senior School
 - i. Senior school students are required to source and pay for their own accompanist.
5. All Entry Forms must be returned to Miss Compton no later than **Friday 12 April**.
6. A schedule of performance times will be available at the beginning of Term 2.
7. A timetable for the day's performances is provided at the end of this entry form.
8. **A copy of the music you are performing must accompany your entry form. This is vital for the adjudicator. Entries will not be accepted without this.**

COPYRIGHT

All students participating in the Garland Music Festival must comply with the copyright licences that Hale School operates under.

An AMCOS/ARIA Form 2 must accompany every photocopy that is made for the adjudicators and is attached at the back of this entry form.

This photocopy must be made from the original music, not from a photocopy. Please check ALL music with Candy Harper before handing it in to Miss Compton along with your entry form.

The Garland Music Festival 2019 will give all students the opportunity to perform as an instrumentalist in friendly competition with their peers as well as to watch performances by younger and older musicians. Between 10.00am and 2.30pm students who have entered will be scheduled to perform to a supportive audience and an adjudicator. There will be several different sessions running concurrently in different rooms in the Music and Drama Centre. Students, family and friends are encouraged to watch and enjoy performances in different sessions throughout the day.

An external adjudicator with expertise specific to each section will adjudicate (provide comments) each performer. The top three performers from Junior School and Middle School, together with the top performer for each Senior School section will be announced at the start of the Final Concert which will be held in the Auditorium at 3.00pm. These students will then perform, and Lady Garland will select the overall Garland Music Prize winner for Junior, Middle and Senior School.

Whilst you may or may not agree with the adjudications throughout the day, these decisions are final, and one must refrain from contesting against these decisions. It is not in the good spirit of friendly competition and could leave a 'sour taste' at the end of what should be a wonderful whole school Music event. Hale Music always encourages students to do their very best in performances, to humbly accept advice and results, and to celebrate the company of outstanding musicians whom they are surrounded by.
