The Hale School Foundation Brian Clarkson Rural Scholarship is named in honour of Brian Clarkson, a dearly loved teacher and well-respected Head of Boarding who passed away in 2011.

Details of the Scholarship:

This scholarship is available for boys who will be in Year 6 in 2021, wanting to enter Hale in Year 7 in 2022 as a boarder. All applicants must come from a regional background.

Scholarships immediately attract a fee reduction of 25% of the tuition fee. A needs-based approach to further fee reductions will require the School to make a financial assessment of individual circumstances.

A Foundation Scholar retains the title for the duration of his secondary schooling. Subject to satisfactory performance and progress, the remission of tuition fees may be awarded for the duration of secondary schooling.

Successful applicants will be good young men who are committed to their studies and can demonstrate involvement in other interests and their community. While academic application is important, we are interested in well-rounded students who will embrace this opportunity.

It is not necessary for your son to sit an examination for this scholarship unless he would like to also be considered for an Academic or Music Scholarship. Please see the information on Academic and Music Scholarships for further details.

The awarding of the Brian Clarkson Rural Scholarship will be determined by:

- completion of application form
- submission of the student's birth certificate
- submission of last three school reports and most recent NAPLAN results
- provision of a referee from the applicant's current school
- completion of the written submission as per the application form

Boys will be shortlisted for an interview based on their application.

Applications close Friday 12 February 2021.
