Hale School Foundation Academic Scholarships are available for boys who will be entering Year 7 in 2022. Any boy who is in Year 6 in 2021 is eligible to apply regardless of the school he currently attends.

Details of the Scholarship:

Scholarships immediately attract a fee reduction of 25%. A needs-based approach to further fee reductions will require the School to make a financial assessment of individual circumstances.

A Foundation Academic Scholar retains the title for the duration of his secondary schooling. The remission of tuition fees may be awarded for the duration of secondary schooling, subject to satisfactory performance and progress.

The online submission involves a series of questions to be completed by a parent or guardian, and a series of questions for the boy to complete.

The awarding of the Hale School Foundation Academic Scholarship will be determined by:

- completion of an online application
- results of an academic examination
- interview with the Headmaster

Boys will be shortlisted for an interview based on their application and results of the examination. We will request school reports and other supporting documents at this time.

Examination details

Applicants may sit the examination either at Hale School or remotely at their current school. If applying to more than one school, applicants must sit the scholarship examination at the school of their first preference. Please choose the relevant link that suits your needs.

Year 7 Academic Scholarship examination for 2022 entry will be held at Hale School on Saturday 13 March 2021 from 8.30am - 12.30pm.
