How to tie a full Windsor knot:

 Begin by draping the tie over your neck with the wide end on the right, narrow end on the left. The wide end of the tie should be longer than the narrow end.

2. Cross the wide end over the narrow.

 Pull up from underneath to create the foundation of the knot.

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4. Lay the wide end down and to the left.

5. Then around the back of the narrow end and to the right.

 From the front, bring the wide end back up through the centre, towards the neck loop.





7. Bring the wide end back down and then right this time around.

8. Bring the wide end over the front of the narrow end, from right to left.

9. Bring the wide end up into the neck loop from underneath once more.

10. Tuck and pull the wide end through the small loop you've created.

 Straighten it out by pulling the wide end of the tie, then slide the knot up. Adjust as needed, but stop once you get a comfortable, symmetrical triangle.

Tied correctly, it is symmetrical, easy to untie, and doesn't choke the wearer.
