

# Lister Drake Scholarship

The Lister Drake Scholarship commenced in 1995, sponsored by the Old Haleians' Association and assisted by funds bequeathed from the estate of former Deputy Headmaster, Mr Lister Drake.

This Scholarship is dedicated to providing assistance for boys who would enrich Hale School and our community.

## Details of the Scholarship:

The Lister Drake Scholarship is open to students who are in Year 10 in 2026, who are direct descendants of an Old Haleian. *All eligible students are encouraged to apply. Applicants do not currently have to be attending Hale School.*

The scholarship is for Years 11 and 12 and is up to the value of 25% remission of local day tuition fees.

The number of Lister Drake Scholarships and the amount in fee reduction are awarded at the discretion of the Headmaster and representatives of the OHA.

## The awarding of the Lister Drake Scholarship will be determined by:

- completion of an online application
- results of an academic examination
- submission of a handwritten 300-word essay
- interview with the Headmaster and representatives of the OHA

Boys will be shortlisted for an interview based on their application and results of the examination. The awarding of this honour is publicly acknowledged.

Applicants may sit the examination either at Hale School or remotely at their current school. Please choose the relevant link that suits your needs.
